



## **LIANE KATSUKI**

Born in Entre Rios, Bahia, Brazil. Today she is considered to be a jewelry designer and sculptress of high level. She has lived in France, Brazil, Japan, Spain and the Netherlands, where she currently resides. With approximately three hundred exhibitions between individual and group exhibitions, since 1972.

### **ARTISTIC EDUCATION**

After studying Fine Arts in her country (Salvador de Bahia), she completed her studies at the School of Fine Arts in Paris and Toulouse (France). She expands her knowledge of jewelry in Toulouse with Rick Skatula and in Emmen (Holland) with Hans Keen. In Holland she polishes the techniques of sculpture in the workshop of Noud Wolf and the techniques of stained glass in the workshops of Lico and Broeder Aquino. She also served major designers, among them the French Pierre Cardin.
